Mixed-use tower to be Norfolk's tallest building

Set to be completed in November 2009, Granby Tower will be Norfolk, Va.'s tallest building as well as the region's largest privately owned facility. The \$180 million, 31-story, million-sf structure will include 300 high-end condominiums and 13,000 sf of retail and office space. A six-story parking garage is also planned. Norfolk-based Marathon Development Group is the developer and the Washington, D.C., office of Turner Construction, New York, is the general contractor.
