An eye toward the center

FARMERS BRANCH — Dallas-based **Harwood Internation**al will oversee development of the first phase of a town center in Farmers Branch. The mixed-use complex will surround a future Dallas Area Rapid Transit light rail station near Interstate 35E near Valley View Road, which is scheduled for completion in 2011.

The project will include retail, office, medical, restaurant and residential components, as well as a city hall and other civic buildings. Construction should kick off in early 2005.

The first phase involves 7 acres of what will ultimately be an 81-acre project. A Dr Pepper StarCenter

is being built on another 14 acres. The complex, scheduled to be completed in November, should draw more than 700,000 visitors each year.

Others involved in the town center development include Dallas-based Centex Construction Group and **Humphreys & Partners Architects**, which specializes in multifamily and high-rise residential development.
