The partnership of Apex and Opus found a one-acre site in downtown Minneapolis in a great location with one view of the Falls and one view of downtown. Humphreys & Partners was able to get 280 units per acre in a 39-story condominium tower, with a 1,320-square-foot average, in a modern design with some Art Deco influences. To save a year of construction and many millions of dollars in construction costs, tunnel form construction systems are being utilized, but an innovative design has kept the feeling of free-flowing, open-floor plans. The glass-and-stone building is set to start construction this fall with completion in 2006.

For the site of the old Biltmore Hotel in Palm Springs, with its history as the playground of the rich and famous, Humphreys & Partners wanted to recapture the essence of that era with a nod to the Palm Springs modern style. Using their “Big House” concept as the starting point, the seven- and 10-unit buildings resemble the large vacation homes that were built in the 1940s and 1950s. The deep overhangs, flat roofs, and the integration of indoor and outdoor spaces make this a unique project for residents
